(b) Inspector- 04 (four)


2. These posts will be filled up on deputation basis from amongst the officers of the similar rank working in the formations of Indirect Taxes, Customs or officers holding analogous post in the Directorate Generals/Directorates under CBIC in the same pay scale. Those officers selected for posting in this Directorate would normally be appointed for a period of **3 years**. They will also be eligible for deputation allowance as may be applicable.

3. Applications of the interested and eligible officers may be forwarded to this office with their particulars viz. name, address, education qualifications, date of birth, present posting, date from which present posting held, scale of pay, experience, ACR grading of last five years duly verified and attested by the Additional/Joint Commissioner (P&V) and also "No Objection Certificate" and Vigilance clearance till date from the concerned Commissionerate/Directorate, by or before **10.10.2018**. Application may also be sent by email on the address mentioned above.

4. It may also be brought to the notice of the willing officers that once they are selected they will not be allowed to withdraw their name and also will not be relieved till the expiry of the tenure of three years. Selected officers 'will have to make their own arrangement for residential accommodation. In case, while working in this Directorate, the work and conduct of the officer is not found to be satisfactory, the officer is likely to be reverted back to the parent Commissionerate/Directorate even before completion of the deputation period.

5. It is requested this letter may be widely circulated among the officers under your jurisdiction. This circular is available of official site of CBIC, www.cbic.gov.in. The applicants may refrain from sending advance copies and all applications may be forwarded through proper channel only.
